Fill in the registration fields and click “submit.” You’ll set your own user name and password. Because registration is FREE, you can begin to use MrNussbaum XTEND immediately. No personal information other than your name, school, state of residence, and e-mail address are required. We do not ask for your address, nor do we ask for credit card information. You’ll only enter your credit card information if you decide to purchase programs and this is handled by Paypal.

REGISTRATION OF CLASSES AND STUDENTS

Following registration, the FIRST step is to register your classes and students. This is accomplished by clicking on the large orange “add/edit” students button upon logging in.

With your free registration, you can register up to three classes and 120 total students! Your students can access the site on an unlimited basis --- from school or from home.

Classes

You can name your classes by simply highlighting the “Class 1” text in the first tab and typing in a new name. You can do the same with the the “Class 2” tab and “Class 3” tab. Alternatively, you can leave the generic names.

To add students, simply type their names in the “Names to Add” field. If you have a list of students, you can copy and paste their names all at one time into the field. In the example below, I have named my classes and entered my student names. When satisfied, click the green “add” button and your students will be added. Unique user names and passwords (that can be changed) will also be generated. User names are the first and last names combined into one word (with the first letter of first name capitalized along with the first letter of last name) unless the combined word is already taken as a user name, in which case characters will be added to it.

Passwords are strings of six jumbled lower case letters and numbers. Simply highlight the string in a username or password field to change. After you are satisfied, **MAKE SURE YOU CLICK THE SAVE BUTTON AT THE BOTTOM RIGHT OF THE PAGE.** You can also print out a list of classes with user names and passwords that can be cut and distributed to students.



Once your students are registered, you can begin using the programs to deploy specific activities to students. After you save your student log in information, you'll click the green "back to programs" button. On the new screen, you'll see two sides, one labeled "My Programs" and the second labeled "Other Available Programs."

MY PROGRAMS

These programs are those that you gain full use of upon free registration. There are nine free programs. Full printable instructions are available upon opening the programs. These programs will always be free to use and you'll never have to renew.


OTHER AVAILABLE PROGRAMS

It will take up to 24 hours for all of your purchased programs to become available in your MrNussbaum XTEND console (We manually enabled them).

SITE FEATURES

MrNussbaum XTEND is a drag and drop program where teachers, parents, or homeschoolers deploy resources from the programs for students to complete. The system keeps track of all student activity and scoring in the teacher “record book” that can be found in all programs. In general, there are three types of resources that can be deployed.

Pre-loaded Activities – For most of the programs on MrNussbaum XTEND, there are pre-loaded activities that can be deployed to students. For example, for Reading Comprehension Central there are 169 different exercises that can be deployed to students, for Cloze Reading, there are 51. Some programs have less pre-loaded material (such as Spelling Central) because of the individual nature of such content.

Custom-made Activities – For most of the programs on MrNussbaum XTEND (other than the game-based programs), teachers can add their own content to deploy to students. For example, teachers can add their own reading passages and questions in Reading Comprehension Central, their own paragraphs in Cloze Reading, their own spelling lists in Spelling Central and so on. Create buttons are always RED.

Teacher Exchange Activities – Registered users on MrNussbaum XTEND can also use custom-made activities created by other teachers in the Teacher Exchange. Here, teachers can copy activities made by their peers and deploy them to their own students.

DEPLOYING ACTIVITIES TO STUDENTS

Activities on MrNussbaum XTEND are deployed to students in the same way across all programs. Deployable activities are available on the left side in the “To Deploy” Menu. Clicking on a specific activity from the “To Deploy” menu will launch a preview of the activity, and dragging it to the “To Be Deployed” space then makes it eligible to be delivered to students. There is no limit to the number of activities that can be deployed at the same time. See picture below:

STUDENTS

Students complete the activities you deployed from their own accounts using the user names and passwords you generated for them. Each student has a unique account. For this reason, it is NOT advisable to use the same password for each student. Students log in from the same place teachers log in.

Please note: Specific activities do not become available to students until you deploy them.

When students complete items you deploy, records and statistics will become available from the “Record Book” of each program. Record Books can be sorted by student or by individual activity. You can see what was answered correctly and incorrect as well as graph progress charts.

REWARDS

You can program rewards to students for any reason, or, for achievement on specific activities. Open the rewards program to learn more. Rewards come in the form of world flags, magic coins, or your classroom currency. Students “collect” the flags and coins which can be traded with classmates.

STUDENT-MADE ACTIVITIES

For several programs, you can deploy students the ability to make their own activities and then to invite their classmates to participate. For example, students can create their own board games and can create their own class polls. We’re working on increasing this functionality to include several of the other programs.

COMMUNICATION

The self-explanatory messaging system is free with registration. You can send messages to students, receive messages from students, and connect students on a student-by-student basis, enabling them to communicate with each other.

This is just a brief summary on getting started. There are minor differences from program to program, but each functions in the ways described here. For more information on those programs, please view the videos or printables available on the site specific to those programs.
