

## Antagonist Trading Card

Instructions – Think of an antagonist (evil character) from movies, literature, or history, and make him or her the subject of a trading card. The card has a specific format. At the top of the card, you should put the name of the book, movie, or historical event in which your antagonist is involved. You should draw or print out an in-action picture of your antagonist in the space below the top space. This picture should be colorful. In the circle, you should draw or print a profile picture of your antagonist's face. Next to this picture, you should make his or her actual name. You can write a description of your chosen antagonist on the back. Below is an example from American history!
