Run Batted In (RBI)	When four pitches are “balls,” or pitches that aren’t strikes. The batter is awarded first base.
Error	When the batter hits a home run and there are runners on first, second, and third base.
Walk	When the batter makes a play that results in a run or runs being scored.
Strikeout	When the batter hits the ball and makes it to third base.
Double Play	When the batter gets three strikes and is out. Strikes can happen from a foul ball, a swing and miss, or, from the umpire calling a strike. A foul ball, however, cannot be strike three.
Grand Slam	When the team playing the field records two outs in a single play.
Double	When a player in the field makes a mistake in catching, fielding, or throwing.
Triple	When the batter hits the ball and makes it to second base.
