1.	Trees in the emergent layer of the Amazon Rainforest may be feet in circumference. Many are braced by hugeroots.
2.	Most of the fruits that grow in the rainforest do so in the layer. In this layer, plants called provide small pools of drinking water for animals and breeding grounds for frogs.
3.	Because there is little to any wind in the understory, plants rely on insects and animals to their flowers.
4.	The bright coloration of the Scarlet Ibis comes from its diet.
5.	In the 1950s, it was thought that at least percent of Earth was covered by rainforests. Today, only about percent of the planet is covered by rainforests.
6.	At the rate of the current destruction of the Amazon rainforest, it would be entirely gone in the next years.
7.	There are over documented species of poison dart frogs living within the Amazon Rainforest. The secretions of these animals have been used by indigenous peoples to poison the tips of their
