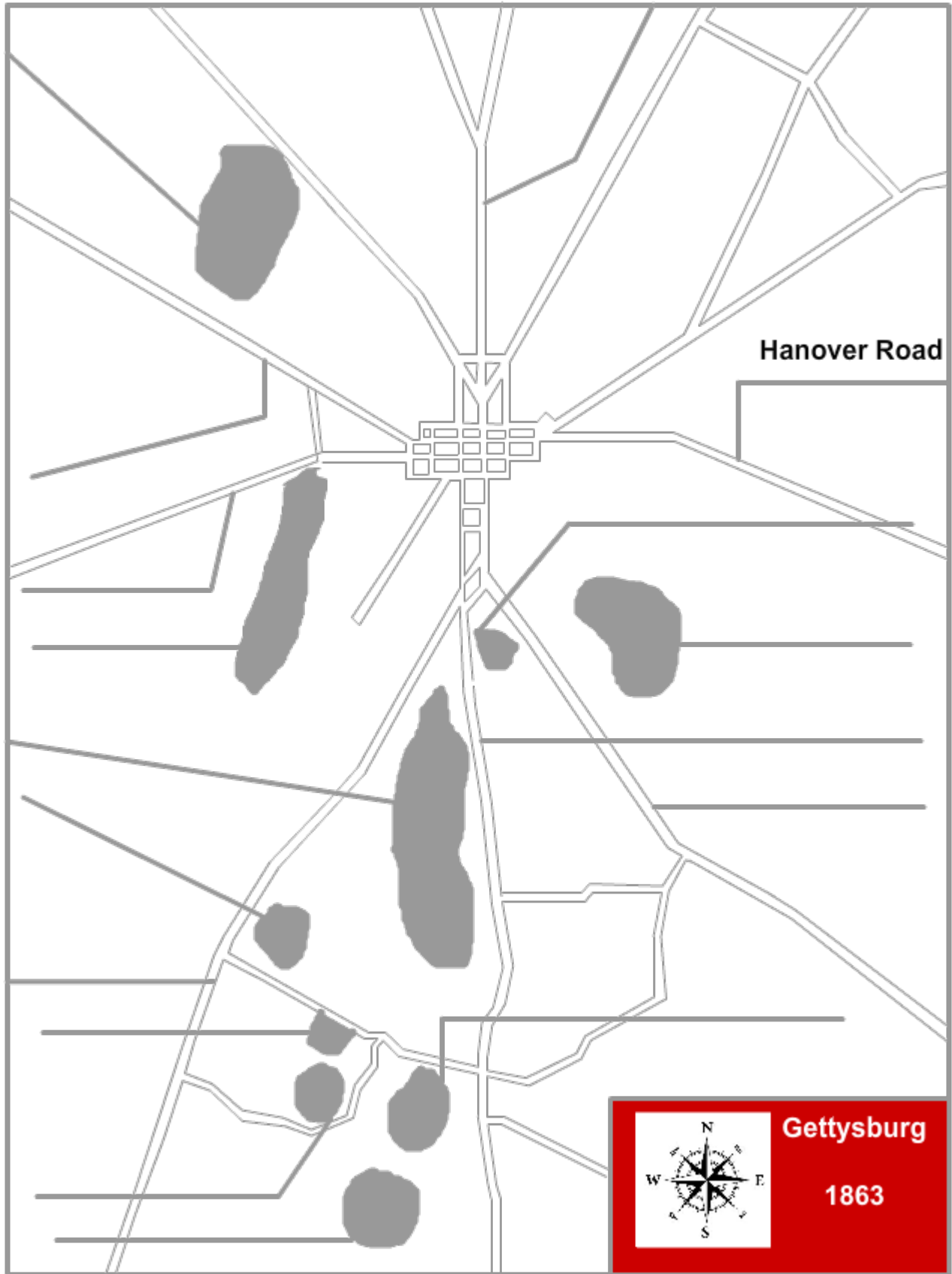


Gettysburg Landmarks

The Battle of Gettysburg was the largest battle ever waged on American soil. Many of the battlefields and landmarks as part of the National military park are famous by themselves. Review the directions below and then label the parts of the battle map. You'll have to follow the directions carefully to make sure you label everything correctly. The Hanover Road is labeled for you.

The Chambersburg Pike	Road that leads northwest from Gettysburg
The Baltimore Pike	Road that leads southeast from Gettysburg
Culp's Hill	Southeast of town, between the Baltimore Pike and Hanover Road
Little Round Top	Due south of Cemetery Ridge and due east of Devil's Den
Cemetery Ridge	Nearly due south of town between Emmitsburg Road and Taneytown Road
Seminary Ridge	Southwest of town between Emmitsburg Road and Fairfield Road
Peach Orchard	Just northwest of the wheatfield.
Devil's Den	Just west of Little Round Top
Emmitsburg Road	Road that leads southwest from Gettysburg
Fairfield Road	Runs opposite of the Chambersburg Pike, slightly to the southwest of town
The Wheatfield	Due east of the Peach Orchard
McPherson Ridge	Ridge northwest of Gettysburg next to the Chambersburg Pike
Hanover Road	Road that travels east from Gettysburg
Taneytown Road	Road that leads due south from Gettysburg
Carlisle Road	Road that leads due north of Gettysburg
Cemetery Hill	Slightly west of Culp's Hill in between Taneytown Road and Baltimore Pike
Round Top	Due south of Little Round Top
