Do you know the differences between the different kinds of roads?

Boulevard - a wide city street lined with trees and vegetation.
Avenue - a wide city street that runs perpendicular to streets.
Street - A public way that has buildings on either side. Streets run perpendicular to avenues.
Drive - A long, winding road shaped by its surroundings.
Parkway - A broad thoroughfare with a grassy or treed median and side strips.
Highway - A main road, usually between major cities or towns
